At 12:00 noon, President Elaine Youngberg called the business meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

Jay Rampton, treasurer, presented a proposal to donate \$15,000 to the new Bountiful Historical Museum. Motion carried.

Carol Merrill, genealogist, introduced current research on Henry Rampton's ancestors. Arlene Eakle, the Association's hired genealogist, reported a breakthrough on several generations of Henry's ancestors.

President Youngberg introduced the last living grandchild of Henry Rampton, Fawn Jetta Rampton Beesley, descendant of Walter Rampton and Emily Young. Walter is Henry and Frances Dinwoodey's sixth child. Fawn attended the reunion with all her children, Tim, Brian, Jill and Deborah, and their spouses.

President Youngberg reported that DNA samples were gathered from Fawn Beesley and from John Robertson Rampton, Jr., who was the last living descendant from Henry and Ada Alice MacDuff and who passed away two months ago.

President Youngberg announced the deaths of John R Rampton, Jr. and his wife, Mary Stringham Rampton. She also announced the passing of Colette Holbrook Sheets.

President Youngberg reported that the book on Henry Rampton, his wives, his children and his grandchildren is now in the final stages of proof reading and will be ready to go to press very soon.

Robert Taylor offered a prayer and a blessing on the food.

144 persons (40 families) attended the reunion this year, the second-highest attendance since 2005.

The reunion adjourned at 2 p.m.
