Malcolm M. Rampton

Malcolm MacDuff Rampton, 80, 644 22nd, died this morning in the Dee Hospital after a heart attack.

Mr. Rampton was born May 4, 1881, in Bountiful, a son of Henry and Ada Alice MacDuff Rampton. He married Martha (Mattie) Gibson on Nov. 22, 1905, in the Salt Lake Temple.
